In 1993, Christine underwent an innovative minimally invasive surgery at The Children's to repair a hole in her heart. She was in the operating room at 8 a.m., and by 8 p.m. she was back at home playing. Christine's experience illustrates The Children's commitment to the continual advancement of pediatric care.

**“At any other hospital in Montreal, my daughter would have undergone open heart surgery, followed by a lengthy recovery, and been left with a prominent scar,” said Greg Rokos, President and CEO at ESI Technologies.**

A loyal advocate of The Children's for the past 20 years, Mr. Rokos is a past Chair and current member of The Children's Foundation Board of Directors and Campaign Cabinet. He donates both time and financial resources to ensure sick children from across Quebec benefit from the same high standard of care that profoundly impacted his family.

Taking it a step further, Mr. Rokos is participating in The Children's Legacy Challenge. He has signalled his intent to leave a donation, or 'bequest' in his will. Thanks to this campaign, 20% of the value of his contribution, up to a maximum of \$200,000, will be matched to support critically ill children who need help right now. Later, his legacy will empower The Children's researchers, doctors, caregivers, and support staff to continue providing innovative care to benefit not only his descendants but also every sick child in Quebec, long into the future.

Mr. Rokos included his children in his gift planning decision. They were pleased with the news and consider it a gift from the entire family.
